## High School News—Post-season Meets

### Ohioans Compete at Midwest Meet of Champions

JACKSON, MI – Eight area athletes represented Ohio at the annual Midwest Meet of Champions, a senior-only competition between teams from Ohio, Michigan and Indiana.

Woodmore's [Erin Pendleton](#) and Delta's [Korbin Smith](#) each continued their winning ways from the Ohio state championships and were victorious in the discus throw (160' 5") and long jump (23' 2½") respectively. Anthony Wayne's [Erika Schmidt](#) also won, taking the 200 meters in 24.62.

[Crosby Schemenauer](#), the Division II pole vault state champion on Eastwood's winning team, took sixth in his event (15'). Former Division I shot put champion, Scott's [Shatora Lewis](#), was fourth (40' 6¼").

Whitmer's [Moise Frisch](#) ran the 1600 meters and placed third in a personal-record time of 4:13.84. Genoa thrower [Marcus Vicars](#) did double duty, taking third in the shot put (58' 5") and fifth in the discus throw (160' 11").

Pendleton also competed in the shot put, placing seventh (37' 4½"). Schmidt ran on the 4x200 relay which took second (1:40.79) along with Anthony Wayne teammate Ashley Zaper.

Ohio narrowly lost to Michigan in the boys' competition, 171.5 to 168, and easily won the girls' competition, 223 to 173. Indiana was last in both.

### Kaiser Sets Michigan Record

LISLE, IL – Nick Kaiser, a sophomore at Bedford, placed third in the 800 meters at the [Midwest Distance Gala](#). His time of 1:51.83 establishes a new Michigan high school record for sophomores, and is the top sophomore time in the USA.

Kaiser, the Michigan Division 1 champion, led the race with 200 meters remaining, but was passed by Danny Neff of Vandalia-Butler, Ohio's Division I champion.

### Pendleton Finalist at NCAA

FAYETTEVILLE, AR – [Emily Pendleton](#), a sophomore at the University of Michigan and a 2007 graduate of Woodmore High School, placed ninth in the discus throw at the [2009 NCAA Outdoor Track & Field Championships](#).

Her throw of 160' 11" (49.06m) left her less than two feet shy of eighth place, which would have scored a point for the Wolverines. Michigan finished the championships at John McDonnell Field in seventh place, far and away the best showing of any Big Ten team.

Pendleton, the two-time Big Ten discus champion, improved on her 14th-place finish at last year's NCAA championships.

She was eleventh in the qualifying round (50.96 meters) and was remarkably consistent in the finals, with all six throws between 46.71 and 49.06 meters.

COLUMBUS – Perrysburg's Matt Folk was third in the [Columbus 10k](#) in a time of 30:46.37, and former Southview runner Paige Biglin was eighth in the women's race in 39:21.27.
